**AIMEE BARNES** is a musical theatre performer, director, and teaching artist based in New York, with performance credits that include Dr. Carol in *Pieces* at the Turtle Shell Theatre in NYC; New York productions of *A Christmas Carol*, *The Envelope Please*, *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, and *The Tamer Tamed*; performance work with the Puppetry Arts Theatre; a national tour of *Cinderella* (as the Fairy Godmother); and regional productions of *I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, and *A Christmas Carol*. A Phi Beta Kappa member, she graduated *magna cum laude* from American University. Her directing experience includes the summer programs at the Lake Dillon Theatre Company and the Emma Willard School. Ms. Barnes currently teaches voice and piano with Soyulla Artists.

University of Miami alumnus **ADAM GILBERT** is an active singer, songwriter, composer, music director, producer, and teacher. His two CD releases have received national airplay and five-star ratings on iTunes, and *NeuFutur* Magazine described his single "Break Through Today" as "a modern masterpiece of songwriting with an innovative sense of musical adventure; the resulting sound achieved ... is something that has not previously been heard." His schedule includes engagements at the Bitter End in Greenwich Village, classical concerts, and producing/mixing gigs for venues like PBS. Mr. Gilbert serves as music director at a church in Vernon and at Centenary College. His students have received acceptances to many renowned college music programs. He is a member of the Vocal Conservatory Faculty at PeachCraft Studios.

**ADRIAN ARRIETA**, a former acting and voice student at PeachCraft Studios, is now the first member of its Dance faculty. He served as choreographer and played Archibald Craven in PDVF's summer 2010 production of *The Secret Garden*. Mr. Arrieta received a Paper Mill Playhouse Rising Star Award for his performance in *The Producers* at his alma mater, Summit High School. His professional credits include *Peter Pan* and *Disney's High School Musical* at the Paper Mill Playhouse. He has danced (on full scholarship) with the Manhattan Youth Ballet and studied at the prestigious CAP21 conservatory in New York City.

**KATE KENNEDY**, founder and director of PeachCraft Studios, is a professional film producer, master acting coach, and casting director with over 25 years of experience in Los Angeles, San Francisco, and New York. After graduating with a bachelor's degree from Marymount Manhattan College, Ms. Kennedy began her acting career touring with San Francisco's famed Lilliput Players Theatre Troupe and made her television debut in NBC's "Midnight Caller." Beginning with *The Joy Luck Club*, she has amassed a distinguished list of casting director credits from the major motion picture studios and TV networks in Los Angeles, including DreamWorks Studios, Paramount Pictures, the Walt Disney Studios, Miramax, HBO, NBC, and CBS. At PeachCraft, Ms. Kennedy teaches a distinctive imagination-based technique for inspired acting, fusing the methods of Constantine Stanislavski, Michael Chekhov, and Stella Adler with her own concepts.
